

BOOGIE MAMA MUSIC: I start in E flat major. I also shift to c minor scale after the opening sequence:

Keys with flats often have a softer, more mellow quality. Keys with multiple flats, like E-flat major, are often used in genres like jazz and blues. they use the same notes but start on different pitches; C minor starts on C while E flat major starts on E flat.

- **Blues**

The C minor blues scale is C - E ♭ - F - G ♭ - G - B ♭ . The minor blues progression is characterized by a distinctive descending chord progression by half steps.

- **Jazz**

The minor blues progression is occasionally used in jazz, as in the songs Mr. PC by John Coltrane and Stolen Moments by Oliver Nelson. The melodic minor scale, which is a diatonic major scale with a lowered third, is also used in modern jazz harmony.
